## Section – B: Numerical Ability (20 x 1 Mark = 20 Marks)

This section is designed to test the candidate's ability to work with numbers consisting of arithmetic, algebra, geometry and interpretation of tables and graphs of 10<sup>th</sup> class or SSC Standard.
